

Bus changes in Term Two

Route 605 Eastern Shore to Dominic College

Change

Bus timetables in Greater Hobart will change on **3 May 2026**.

From Term Two 2026 (Monday 4 May 2026), students travelling to Dominic College on route 605 will need to be at the bus stop earlier and change to a different bus at the Glenorchy Interchange.

What this means for your journey

- Catch route 605 from stops between Tranmere, Rosny Park, Hobart and Moonah
- The bus will arrive at the Glenorchy Interchange (Stop E) at 8.08 am
- Get off the bus and walk to Stop D
- Catch the route 223 school bus that departs at 8.17 am

Plan your journey before the start of Term Two and make sure you are at the bus stop at the right time.

You can plan future journeys using journey planning apps from 1 April 2026. PDF timetables will be available to preview online from 17 April 2026 at transport.tas.gov.au/bus-network-review.

Reason

The Department of State Growth is reviewing the current Greater Hobart bus network. This review includes the public bus network currently operated by Metro, Tassielink and Kinetic and the Metro school bus network. No other school bus services are affected.

As the first step of the review, bus timetables in Greater Hobart will change on 3 May 2026 to better reflect actual travel conditions and ensure students get to school on time.

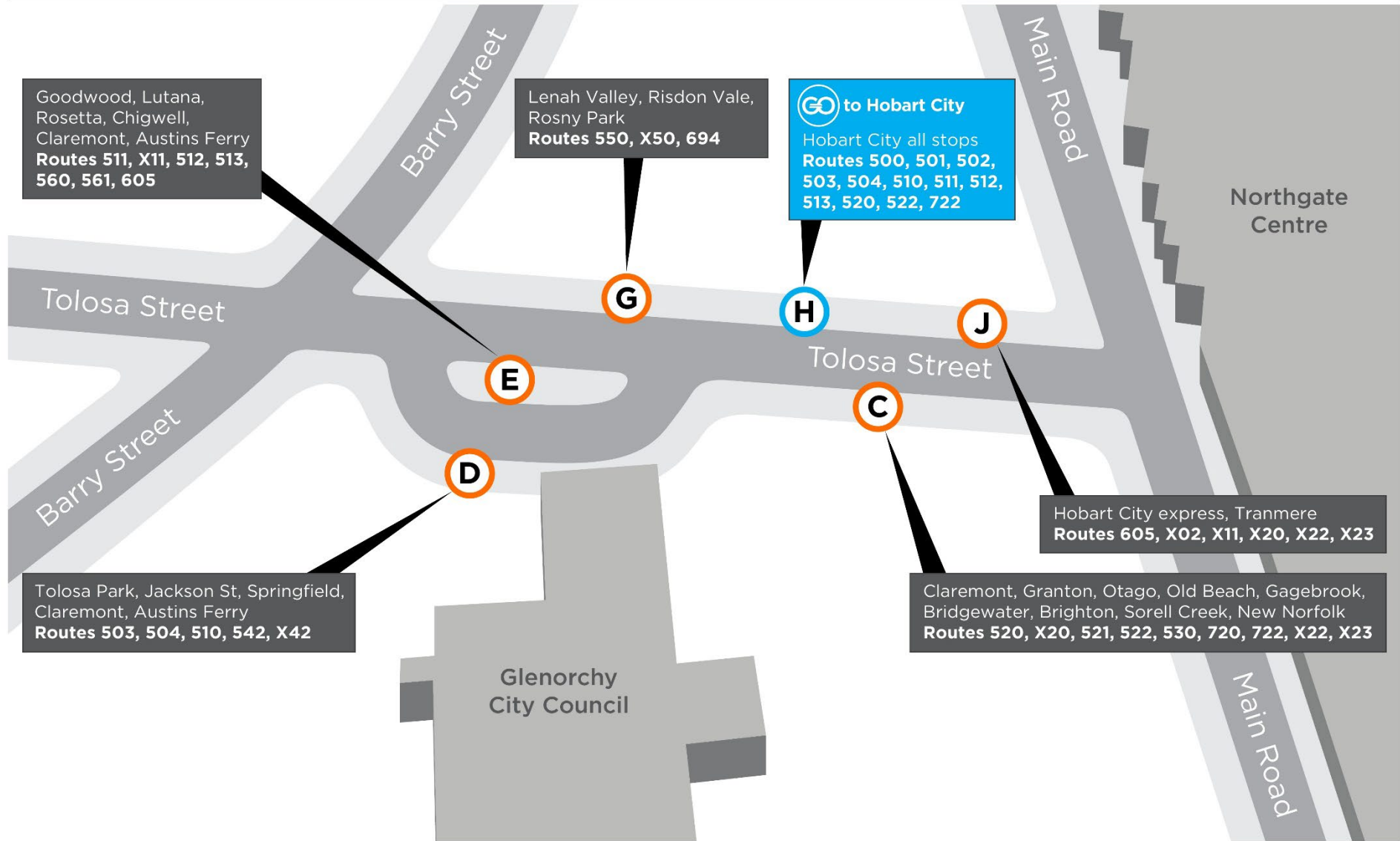
